

Multisyllable Words with Vowel Sound #3 - /i/

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Two-syllable words are sorted into two large groups depending upon which syllable the targeted vowel sound appears, 1st or 2nd. Within those two groups, two divisions occur.

- 1) **Basic Consonants** consists of words with only Basic Code consonant spellings
- 2) **Adv Consonants** consists of words with any Advanced Code consonant spelling.

Note: For the first five Basic Code vowel sound spellings, a, e, i, o and u, no words are included with vowel sounds of a higher class. Thus, the /a/ list includes *only* words with the vowel sound /a/ spelled with the letter “a.” The /e/ list includes words with vowel sound /e/, spelled “e” and *can* include words with /a/ sounds, etc. The result is that the first five lists contain all of the words in the database with vowel sounds spelled with only Basic Code vowel spellings and each word appears on only one of the lists. Without this limitation, the lists would each be over 500 words long.

Three-syllable words are sorted into three groups depending on which syllable the targeted vowel sound appears, 1st, 2nd or 3rd but not into levels of code used in the word.

Words with four, five or six syllables are sorted just by the number of syllables.

Note: Words are *not* divided into formal syllables. The divisions are according to the method used in the OnTrack Reading curriculum’s *Main Rule and Three Exceptions*.
