

## Multisyllable Words with Vowel Sound #15 - /oul/

*Two-syllable words* are sorted into two large groups depending upon which syllable the targeted vowel sound appears, 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup>. Within those two groups, three divisions occur.

- 1) **Basic Consonants** consists of words with only Basic Code consonant spellings
- 2) **Adv Consonants** consists of words with any Advanced Code consonant spelling.
- 3) **Advanced Vowels** consists of words containing vowel sounds not yet covered in the OnTrack Reading curriculum's vowel sequencing.

*Three-syllable words* are sorted into three groups depending on which syllable the targeted vowel sound appears, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> but not into levels of code used in the word.

*Words with four, five or six syllables* are sorted just by the number of syllables.

**Note:** Words are *not* divided into formal syllables. The divisions are according to the method used in the OnTrack Reading curriculum's *Main Rule and Three Exceptions*.
