

One Syllable Words with Vowel Sound IE

The /ie/ sound is spelled five ways in the OnTrack Reading curriculum and is taught immediately before the /ee/ sound so that students can easily be shown the overlap between the spellings the /ie/ and /ee/ sounds.

The words in the list below start with basic code consonant spellings, then progress to more complex consonant spellings. The words marked with an asterisk (*) contain consonant spellings that are not taught explicitly in the OnTrack Reading curriculum. Words with a double asterisk (**) contain very rare spellings of a sound.
