

One Syllable Words with Vowel Sound OE

The /oe/ sound is spelled seven ways in the OnTrack Reading curriculum and is taught immediately after the /ow/ sound so that students can easily be shown the strong overlap between the /ow/ and /oe/ spellings.

The words in the list below start with basic code consonant spellings, then progress to more complex consonant spellings. The words marked with an asterisk (*) contain consonant spellings that are not taught explicitly in the OnTrack Reading curriculum. Words with a double asterisk (**) contain very rare spellings of a sound.
